### ADMISSION POLICY & PROCESS

| Admission Process | <p>Private and subsidized resident will be assessed by Chief Nurse/ Nurse Manager/ Case Manager Medical Social Worker prior to admission and resident are to submit their latest Medical Report/ X-ray before or upon admission.</p> <p>Upon admission, the following fees are to be paid by PayNow (<b>UEN 201014368N</b>) or cash.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) One month nursing fee deposit depending on resident's category (non-subsidized which is refundable upon discharge), to be paid before/ on the day of admission.</li> <li>2) One month nursing fee (pro-rated for current month), to be paid before/on the day of admission.</li> </ol>   |
| Admission Timing  | Monday (10am to 11am), Thursday (10.00am to 4.00pm), Friday (10am to 11am)  |
| Discharge         | Two weeks' advance written notice is required for discharge of resident, failing which the full deposit paid will be forfeited.   |
| Nursing Fee       | <p><b>\$81 to \$154</b> per day depending on resident's category and subsidy tier. The nursing fee covers nursing care, all meals, daily laundry, in-house doctor's consultation fee, standard medication, special feeds such as thickener &amp; standard milk feed, transport (shared/MH's transport) for doctor's appointments (with next-of-kin's company). Escort service may be chargeable @ \$30/hr (subject to manpower availability). The Home's nursing fee is to be paid in advance by the second week of each month. (Please note that resident's original NRIC will be safe-kept with the Home in accordance with the Home's policy and a duplicate copy of the decision maker's NRIC must be given to Moral Home).</p> |

Clothing Resident is required to bring 3 to 5 sets of comfortable home clothes upon admission. Resident/Next-of-Kin is required to replace new sets when needed.

Other items to bring along upon admission are as follows:

1. Three sets of small face towels and large bath towels.
2. A pair of comfortable footwear.
3. Jacket, if available.
4. Thermal mug (small and light) with name written, if available.

**Important to note:**

- **For Long-Term Residents**  
In the event that there are outstanding nursing fees and Next-of-Kin is uncontactable, Moral Home will collect all future government grants on behalf of the residents, to defray the monthly Nursing Fee.
- Resident will be excluded from activities conducted by volunteers and donors if the Consent Form for "Waiver of Liability for participation of activities" and "Photo of Media Release" is not signed and submitted.
- Visitors are not allowed to visit resident at the ward without permission from the nurse in-charge.
- Moral Home focuses on nursing care for residents. Our Long-Term Care service includes exercises and activities. Participation in exercises/activities will base on the individual's health and willingness to participate.
- For safety and well-being of our residents and staff, Moral Home reserved the right to put up transfer of resident, if Resident /Resident's Next-of-Kin is uncooperative and does not comply to our rules and regulations.
